- 5. Organize your thoughts and write an outline before beginning the essay. Do not spend more than two minutes writing the outline.

 - b) Develop your own perspective.
 - c) Develop a thesis.
 - d) Identify three to four important points.
 - e) Decide on the order of presentation of the major points.
- 6. Organize ideas into paragraphs.
 - a) Begin with an introduction.
 - b) Create three to four body paragraphs.
 - c) End with a conclusion.
- 7. Write using correct grammar.
- 8. Write clearly, concisely, and legibly.
