## 46. (H) ORG 20-27

According to the right-hand graph, by the time the project was completed in 1991 (having reached the planned 42,500 miles), the total cost was approximately \$130 billion (the federal portion of which was about \$115 billion). The Highway Act allocated \$25 billion federal dollars to the system. When it had reached 42,500 miles in 1991, the federal share of the cost was approximately \$115 billion dollars. This is more than four times the original expected cost, (H).
